

# 2008 – 2009 Peace College Housing Application

Peace College students are required to live on campus their first two years and until they complete 60 academic credit hours. Students may be exempt if they are over 21 years of age, married, have dependants, or live within a 30 mile radius with their legal guardians. All students who feel they should be exempt from the housing requirement need to complete the Housing Exemption Form and return it with their \$150.00 deposit to the Admissions Office. Students will be considered Residential until their Housing Exemption forms are received and approved.

___ Ross Hall	primarily houses first year students. One hundred and eighteen students live on three floors in suites where four students share a bathroom. A large laundry room, kitchen, and exercise room are located in the basement area.
