DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER

The mission of the Peace College Disability Resource Center is to provide equal access to the educational environment for students with disabilities. It is also our desire to enable students to understand and manage their disability in order to successfully achieve their individual goals. In this spirit, the office assists students with disabilities in accessing and using appropriate accommodations, and in making sound choices about course load, study skills, strategies and self-advocacy.

Students who have registered with Disability Resource Center are responsible for making an appointment with the office director at the beginning of each semester in order to write a current academic accommodations plan. This allows students to discuss the accommodations with each of their instructors and garner the necessary signatures on the plan during the first week of classes. This early planning ensures that students will receive their accommodations in a timelier manner and that the waiting time for appointments and paperwork processing will be greatly minimized.

HOW TO REGISTER

- Call or email our office at the address to the right. Request the Disability Services Registration Packet.
- Follow the guidelines in the packet in order to provide us with the appropriate documentation.
- When we receive your documentation, we will contact you to schedule an Initial Accommodations Plan appointment.
- Once this plan is in place, you will have accommodations for the semester. The request for accommodations must be renewed by you each semester.
- This process can take several weeks or more to establish, so please begin as soon as possible after receiving your acceptance letter from admissions.
