



Articulation Agreement Between
Wake Technical Community College
and
William Peace University
Associate in Applied Science Programs

This document summarizes the general terms of the transfer agreement between Wake Technical Community College (WTCC) and William Peace University (WPU) for the transfer of:

1. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Business Administration – General Business concentration to WPU's Bachelor of Science, Business Administration.
2. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Business Analytics to WPU's Bachelor of Science, Business Analytics.
3. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Criminal Justice Technology to WPU's Bachelor of Science, Criminal Justice.
4. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Health and Fitness Science to WPU's Bachelor of Science, Exercise and Sport Science.
5. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Health and Fitness Science to WPU's Bachelor of Arts, Sport and Fitness Studies.
6. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Simulation and Game Development – Programming Track to WPU's Bachelor of Arts, Simulation and Game Design.
7. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Simulation and Game Development – Arts Track to WPU's Bachelor of Arts, Simulation and Game Design.
8. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Web Developer to WPU's Bachelor of Arts, Interactive Design.
9. WTCC's Associate in Applied Science, Human Resources Management to WPU's Bachelor of Science, Human Resource Management.

Additional degree programs may be added to this agreement through a separate memorandum of understanding and adoption of a mutually determined Degree Completion Plan (DCP).

Term of Agreement:

This agreement consolidates separate, previous agreements, and hereby renews all in a single, continuous agreement unless and until one of the parties provides notice of modification or termination. The parties agree to notify one another immediately of a substantive change in any of the programs of study. The Degree Completion Plans (DCPs) may be amended, as needed, by mutual agreement without affecting the currency of the master agreement. Both parties agree to communicate the conditions of this agreement to their respective external and internal constituents. WTCC and WPU will review this agreement every year and adjust or amend as deemed appropriate to maintain the integrity of all institutions as well as for the improvement of the transfer process and student articulation. Such changes will not adversely affect students already enrolled and covered under the provision of the existing agreement.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the benefits of this transfer agreement, a student must complete the Associate in Applied Science at WTCC with an overall GPA of 2.0 or better.

Transfer of Credit:

Academic credit earned at WTCC will transfer to WPU as outlined in the transfer matrix hereinafter called a Degree Completion Plan (DCP) included for each AAS as part of this agreement. Only those classes completed with a grade of "C-" or better will transfer. Final determination of credit transferability rests with the WPU Registrar based upon review of student transcripts.

Under this agreement and subject to grade and catalog criteria, WPU will accept all the credits from the AAS degree in bulk transfer. The DCPs will outline courses remaining to complete the baccalaureate degree. In some cases, students may take additional credit at WTCC for transfer to WPU. Students should consult with a WPU Admissions representative to determine applicability of taking additional transfer credit.

Residency Requirement:

As specified in the DCP, students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours of credit at WPU to earn the baccalaureate degree. Graduation eligibility is subject to review and determination by the WPU Registrar based upon a student's transcript and conditions outlined in the WPU Academic Catalog.

Promotion of the Agreement and Evaluation of Success:

The parties agree to promote the terms of this agreement and the student opportunities it embodies through traditional channels including websites, on-campus and virtual transfer events, access to transfer advisors, campus visits and, where possible, completion of coursework and access to facilities under the provisions of the Cooperating Raleigh Colleges.

The parties agree that their respective, designated articulation coordinators will review the agreement, DCPs, and partnership statistics at least once annually.
