

# Checklist

## Orientation

- ❑ **Attend:** New Student Orientation on Jan 10 starting 9am EST. [Register Here.](#)
- ❑ Complete the [Identification Card Request](#) and submit photo for your WPU Student ID.

## Admissions

- ❑ Submit all **final official** transcripts to the Admissions Office
  - ❑ First Year Students: High School (HS) transcript, and any college transcripts if applicable.
  - ❑ Transfer Students: All institutions attended (HS not needed)  
Note: Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.

## Academics

- ❑ Beginning Nov 14 you can meet with Advising Services to discuss your schedule (*only one meeting is necessary*). For instructions on how to sign up for an appointment, check your email for a message with the subject "Schedule your academic advising appointment today!" or look in the Center for Student Success folder on the [Moodle site](#).
- ❑ Check out our Technology Guide on the [Moodle site](#) to get connected and ready for campus life.

## Financial Aid

- ❑ Complete the [FAFSA](#), WPU Code: 002953. (if you have not already done so!)
- ❑ Review the [Financial Aid Checklist](#) and make sure all items have been completed. (Site is very slow to load)

## Billing & Student Accounts

- ❑ [Pay balance](#) for spring term by December 15. Student ID number is required. Parents and Families: Use the guest payment option or set up an Authorized User account with your student. (info on [Moodle Site](#))
- ❑ Complete your [Health Insurance Waiver](#) if you already have health insurance. (note: you will automatically be charged for WPU health insurance if you do not submit the waiver)

## Residence Life & Commuters
